

YEAR 7 HANDBOOK

- Handed out on Orientation Day.

ORIENTATION DAY

- Our Orientation Day is Monday 30th of November (Week 8).
- It will be from **9.30am 2.30pm**. Students will need to be dropped off and picked up from GHS on that day or they may catch the bus.
- All students will be required to wear their primary school uniform.

YEAR GROUP

- We are expecting approximately 160 Students in Year 7 in 2021.
- Students will be split into 6 classes:
 - Selective
 - Gold class
 - Four Mainstream classes
- Students will be in these classes for the majority of their subjects.

UNIFORM

- School uniform must be worn every day. If there is a problem with wearing uniform, students are expected to bring a note from home explaining the concern.
- New uniforms or second hand uniforms can be purchased from the GHS school canteen.
- The canteen will be open during the January school holidays (the dates will be in the year 7 Handbook).


