School resumes for all students

Grafton High School Cross Country / Colour Run

When: 6 April - Last day of school this term

Where: Grafton Showground

This is a normal school day prior to the cross country. Students will need to attend school in full school uniform prior to the event. Students may bring a change of house colour, or older clothes to be a part of the colour run. Coloured Powder will be used (purchased specifically for this event) to colour students if they wish to be coloured. This is optional. Full school uniform will be required at the end of the day. All students will walk back to school after the event and will need full school uniform to depart into the community.

Students can be selected to represent Grafton High School if you wish. The top 10 in each age will represent at the Mid North Coast Cross Country as a competitive runner, or alternately, you can fun-run the course with your mates.

Everybody from Years 7 to 10 will take part by completing 3 laps – It will be part of students recommended 10,000 steps for the day. You choose - competitive running, jog / walk / colour run.

Distances – Your age is the age you turn this year (does not matter if you have turned or are turning). - 3 laps, 18+ 3 laps – long course.

All 7 to 10 students will attend. You will need to have returned your PE permission note that was emailed to you at the beginning of term. Normal classes will be held for Years 11 and 12. Seniors can attend by signing up and then a permission note will be emailed to you. No student will be permitted to attend without returning their permission note.

Staff will walk students to the venue and return with them to school.
